- Hang 10 Group Leaders must have a completed application on file.

Your Commitment to Us:

- Weekly contribution in one of our Beach House service times from September June.
- Arrive at the time designated by the Service Coordinator and stay until all of your children are picked up.
- Quarterly participation in HDC's Kids Leadership Community vision and training meetings.
- Gather with other Hang 10 Group Leaders two times a year as organized by your coach.
- Be available for a monthly contact (phone call, conversation) with your Coach for training.
- Learn kids' names and their parents' names.
- Interact with every child in your group during the weekend service.
- Pray for the kids in your small group.
- Contact your kids outside of the weekend (i.e. send e-mails, phone calls, write notes) at least once a month.
- Connect with your kids by organizing a group outing with another Hang 10 Group Leader at least twice a year.
- Welcome new kids and families and encourage them to get connected at HDC.
- Recognize birthdays and special events in the kids' lives.
- Use the provided curriculum and supplies to facilitate small group discussions, activities, and projects.
- Spend a minimum of 20 minutes each week preparing your small group lesson.
- Encourage kids to contribute by serving on a Beach House Team.
- Care for your kids by finding a substitute on weeks you need to be absent.
- Manage your small group roster by adding and removing names as needed.
- Reproduce yourself by developing an apprentice leader.
- Make a committed effort to help bring new volunteers onto our team.

- To provide training so that you are adequately equipped to serve God in the capacity that He has called you.
